

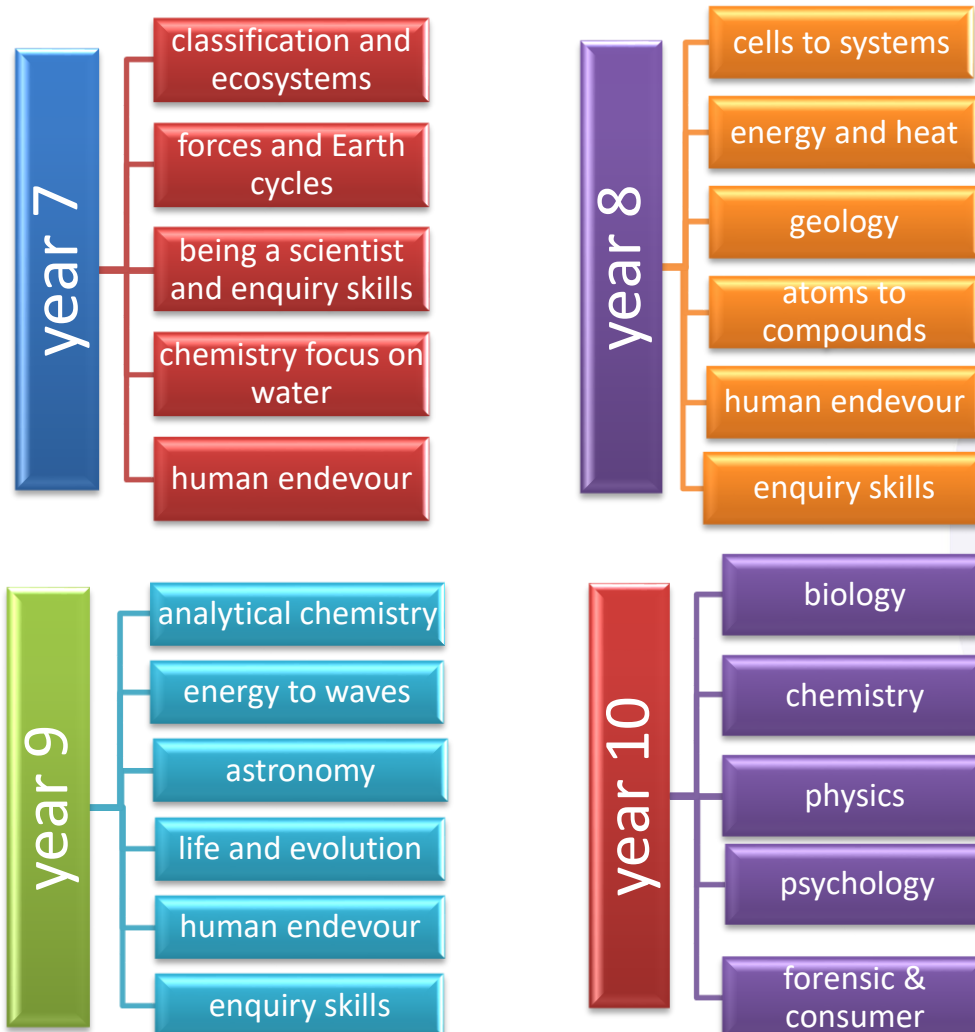


SCIENCE
